School Fees Update:

Bus Pass Applications

This is a reminder to all parents whose child(ren) use the School Bus Transportation System. Please note that your child's bus pass card is good for as long as they are enrolled with GSACRD. Please retain the pass at the end of the school year. Take note that you will still need to apply and pay for bus transportation for the 2017/2018 school year by filling out a bus application form online at www.gsacrd.ab.ca under the transportation tab if you have not already done so. We will electronically re-instate your current bus pass card once the application is received and fees are paid. If you tose your current bus pass over the summer there will be a \$15.00 charge over and above your bussing fee to replace it.

Bus Pass Changes:

Upon the receipt of any new buss pass for your child's, please ensure that you record the number that is on the pass. Effective next year, as a security protocol, student names will no longer be printed on any new bus passes. Since many of our students have their bus passes affixed to the exterior of their back packs, their names were visible to anyone who may be walking in proximity to your child.

Grade 7 / 8 Awards Night


